VISION: Wheatland Union High School sets high standards for both students and staff using collaborative systems of support. We believe every student can obtain academic excellence. Students are given the tools necessary to enhance their work ethic, develop life skills, and utilize today's technology to create college and career connections that have real world relevance.

THE SCHOOL: Wheatland Union High School, a public school located in the northeastern edge of California's vast central Sacramento valley, serves students in grades 9-12. Established in 1907, the school serves an area over 150 square miles which includes Beale Air Force Base and the communities of Plumas Lake and Smartsville. Wheatland Union High School received a full six-year accreditation in 2017 from the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

ENROLLMENT: The student population is approximately 880 with a senior class of 178. In the 2020-21 school year, the racial/ethnic composition consisted of: 51.9% White, 29.5% Hispanic or Latino, 4.1% Black, 2.8% Asian, 1.8% Filipino, 1.8% American Indian, 1.4% Pacific Islander, 4.9% declined to state. 1.8% identify with two or more races. 46.4% of the student population are eligible for free or reduced lunch.

In the 2020-21 school year, 32.6% of seniors and 42.5% of juniors enrolled in one or more Advanced Placement (AP) course.
